Friday nights: Pōwhiri/mihi whakatau and whakawhanaunga at 4pm, followed by Kaitahi (shared dinner) - everyone is required to bring food to share and whānau can stay overnight if they wish to.

Saturdays: Full day of wānanga from 9am – 5pm.
